Membership can last for up to two years and the committee will take place virtually. There may also be opportunities to attend in-person meetings across the season, depending on location.

To be eligible to apply, you must meet the following criteria:

- I will be between 16 – 24 years old as of the 1 September 2023 and live in England.
- I will become a registered member of Basketball England.
- I am passionate about basketball and making sure that the voice of young people within the sport is heard.
- I want all young people, whatever their background, to be a part of the basketball community and have the opportunity to participate in the sport.

All roles with the committee are voluntary.
